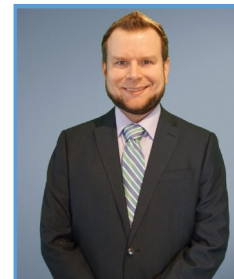

The Triumphal Re-entry

In Matthew 21, the apostle recorded an eyewitness account of the triumphal entry of Christ. According to that testimony, as Jesus approached Jerusalem on a lowly beast of burden, crowds of Jews scattered cloaks and palm branches across the road and joyously exclaimed "*Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!*" (Matthew 21:9).

Clearly, this was an exciting moment for the Jews who genuinely believed Jesus had come to help them throw off the chains of oppression and restore their kingdom to its former glory; but imagine their disappointment when, just a few days later, their Savior was nailed to a cross where He suffered a painful and humiliating death.

Thankfully, we know the story doesn't end there. The Bible teaches that Christ powerfully arose from the grave three days after his crucifixion and that He now reigns in heaven where He patiently awaits the Day of Judgment. On that day Jesus will make the final and triumphal *re-entry* to earth, which will be heralded by a loud trumpet call (Matthew 24:31), the rising of the dead (1 Corinthians 15:52), and the salvation of the faithful saints (1 Thessalonians 4:17).

For some, it will be a day of exuberance and jubilee. But for others, it will be filled with fear and confusion and the horrifying realization that the God they had refused to believe in has come to separate the wheat from the chaff; the faithful from the unfaithful. When that day comes, may we all be found ready with our lamps well-oiled so that we may follow the Bridegroom and receive the inheritance that He has promised.
