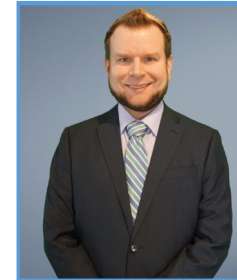

What a Privilege!

Most of us have heard the harrowing true-story behind the hymn, "It Is Well with My Soul", by Horatio Spafford. But there is another song that we sing in our assemblies that was also born out of traumatic circumstances.

In 1855, Joseph Scriven, a Canadian immigrant, wrote a poem to his mother in Ireland upon receiving word that she had become ill. For inspiration, he drew from a personal tragedy that had occurred 10 years earlier in his native country.

On the evening before he was to be married, his fiancé had a terrible accident while on horseback and drowned in a nearby lake. Scriven watched in shock as her lifeless body was pulled from the water and decided then and there that he would travel to America and build a new life for himself.

Over the years, Scriven learned how to fully put his trust in God. Through the precious avenue of prayer, he found peace in spite of the difficult times, and he knew his mother could too. Listen to some of his words:

What a friend we have in Jesus,
All our sins and griefs to bear!
What a privilege to carry
Everything to God in prayer!

Have we trials and temptations?
Is there trouble anywhere?
We should never be discouraged:
Take it to the Lord in prayer.

Are we weak and heavy laden,
Cumbered with a load of care?
Precious Savior, still our refuge,
Take it to the Lord in prayer.

What a unique privilege we have as children of God to take our sins, our pains, our frustrations, our sorrows, our imperfections and so much more before the throne of God. Have you taken advantage of this wonderful avenue of divine communication? It may be just the relief you need!
