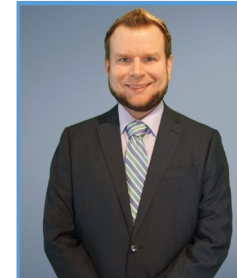

Living with Integrity

Integrity. Many of us are old enough to remember a time when friends, neighbors, and even complete strangers lived and died by this word. Those were the days when cars and homes could be left unlocked, when politicians weren't so political, and when journalists reported the *news* instead of their *views*.

While it seems like those days are far behind us, occasionally a story will appear in the headlines that restores our faith in humanity. One such story is that of Jill James, an Auburn woman who pulled over her vehicle when she saw what she assumed was trash blowing down an Alabama road.

As it turns out, it wasn't trash at all but hundreds of bills totaling over \$14,000. Rather than pocketing the cash, Jill decided to surrender it to the local police who had already been notified that a large sum of money had been missing. Evidently it belonged to a businessman who had temporarily placed the bag of bills on his car and accidentally drove off without it.

Because of her good deed, Jill is being praised in the media as a "Good Samaritan", and rightfully so. Can you imagine if all Christians were as exemplary in honesty and integrity as she was? How might that change how the world views us? How might that change how the world views Jesus?

In Matthew 5:16, He said, "...let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven." These words were echoed by Peter when he exhorted the brethren to "Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation" (1 Peter 2:12).

Clearly, God values honesty and integrity. Do we value Him enough to live by them?
