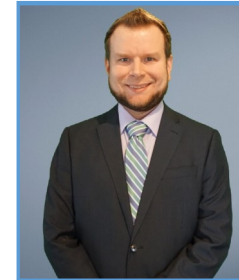

This morning, I'd like to deviate from my "normal" bulletin article to thank our elders for agreeing to host the "His Shoes. Her Shoes." seminar at our building last Saturday. I firmly believe that if we want the Bell Avenue congregation to thrive in this community for years to come, we have got to pray for, promote, and equip our membership for strong marriages.

Too often, the world allows distractions of many kinds to wedge their way between husbands and wives. This can lead to feelings of dejection, angry outbursts, infidelity, divorce, and many other negative or unwanted circumstances. If we aren't careful about prioritizing *our* marriages, we may end up following the same terrifying trajectory, which is why we must be intentional about making them God-centered.

If we never pray together, study the Bible together, share intimate moments together, or submit to one another in love as we are commanded (Ephesians 5:21), then we are doing a terrible disservice to our marriages. Not only that, but we are setting poor examples for our children, grandchildren, and future generations of church leaders to follow.
